

## Mounting Your Dell™ OptiPlex™ XE Using a Wall-Mount Unit



- 1 If you are mounting a computer with the optional Ingress Protection 51 (IP51) kit attached, remove the paddings from the wall-mount unit.




- 2 Mount the wall-mount unit to the wall using the screws that shipped with the unit.




- 3** Place the computer into the wall-mount unit.

Without the IP51 kit




With the IP51 kit




**4** Replace the two screws on the wall-mount unit.
