Dell Server Performance and Resource Optimization Management Pack

Release Notes



This readme provides information on the Dell Server Performance and Resource Optimization (PRO) Management Pack version 2.1, which you can import into Microsoft System Center Operations Manager (SCOM) 2007 SP1/R2 and System Center Essentials (SCE) 2007 SP1/2010.

Dell Server PRO Pack works with SCOM 2007 SP1/R2 or SCE 2007 SP1/2010 and Microsoft System Center Virtual Machine Manager (SCVMM) 2008/R2/R2 with SP1 to manage Dell physical devices and their hosted virtual machines using the available health information from Dell Hardware devices.

Dell PRO Pack recommends remedial actions when monitored objects transition to an unhealthy state (for example, virtual disk failure or predictive drive error), by leveraging the monitoring and alerting capabilities of SCOM/SCE and remediation capabilities of SCVMM.

What's New

- Support for 12th generation of PowerEdge systems.
- Support for Dell OpenManage up to version 7.0 on x9xx to yx2x systems.
- Added support for SCVMM 2008 R2 SP1 and SCE 2010, which supports Virtual Machines Live Migration.
- Added support for additional Open Manage alerts and NIC alerts.
- Live Migration is based on the Virtual Machine Priority based on CPU Utilization.
- In State View, the Managed Nodes are ordered based on Health Status.

Notes

This section provides information to enhance your experience with Dell Server PRO Management Pack for SCVMM 2008, SCVMM 2008 R2, SCVMM 2008 R2 SP1, and SCE 2010.

- Dell Server PRO Management Pack does not monitor informational alerts. You must take appropriate action by looking at the system health in SCOM/SCE (Operations Manager) State view, after implementing PRO Tips.
- Dell Server PRO Management Pack does not provide multiple alerts on sensors (inclusive of current, voltage, fan, and temperature). This means that there is only one sensor event reported for any sensor state transition on a given system. After you have cleared the alert, any subsequent alert is reported.

- Dell Server PRO Management Pack has a default discovery cycle of 24 hours. You can override the discovery cycle time.
- The "Management Station Action Account" needs Administrator privileges to discover systems and PowerShell execution.
- After a system is discovered, if you uninstall OpenManage Server Administrator or OpenManage Server Administrator services are stopped, the health of the Dell PRO Pack discovered system will display as "healthy." However, no alert and PRO Tip is displayed in SCOM/SCE and SCVMM, respectively.
- All Unit Monitors are disabled by default in Dell Server PRO Management Pack.
- Dell Server PRO Management Pack supports upgrade from 2.0 to 2.1 release. Any settings that you override for Dell Server PRO Management Pack 2.0 is carried forward to Dell Server PRO Management Pack 2.1.
- You can override any of the recovery actions:
 - You can override the remedial action of restricting server from hosting new virtual machines when migrating virtual machines.
 - You can override the remedial action of migrating virtual machines when restricting server from hosting new virtual machines.

Open Issues and Resolutions

Issue 1: When you choose to implement multiple PRO Tips during an alert storm, some of the PRO Tips may end up in a failed state.

Issue 2: PRO Tips are generated, even after PRO is disabled in SCVMM.
