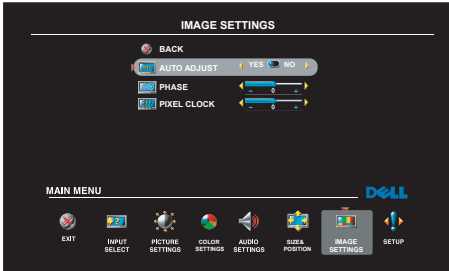

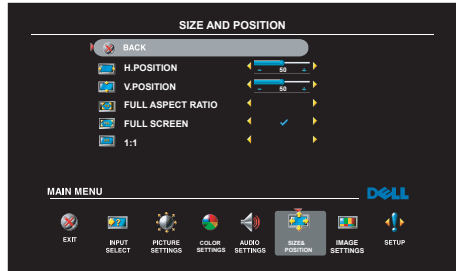

In case VGA/DVI inputs default settings do not provide satisfactory image, refer to the following for additional information on image adjustment features.

Auto Adjust - Allows the monitor to self-adjust to the incoming video signal. After using Auto Adjustment, with VGA input, you can further tune your monitor by using the Pixel Clock (Coarse) and Phase (Fine) controls under **Image Settings** menu, see Fig. 1.

Phase - Use the VOL - and VOL + buttons to make adjustments. (Minimum: 0 ~ Maximum: 63)

Pixel Clock - Use the VOL - and VOL + buttons to make adjustments. (Minimum: 0 ~ Maximum: 100)

If satisfactory results are not obtained using the Phase adjustment, use Pixel Clock (Coarse) and then use Phase (fine), again.

NOTE: Pixel Clock (Coarse) may change the width of the display image.

Use the **H.Position/V.Position** of the **Size & Position** menu to center the display image on the screen, see Fig. 2.
