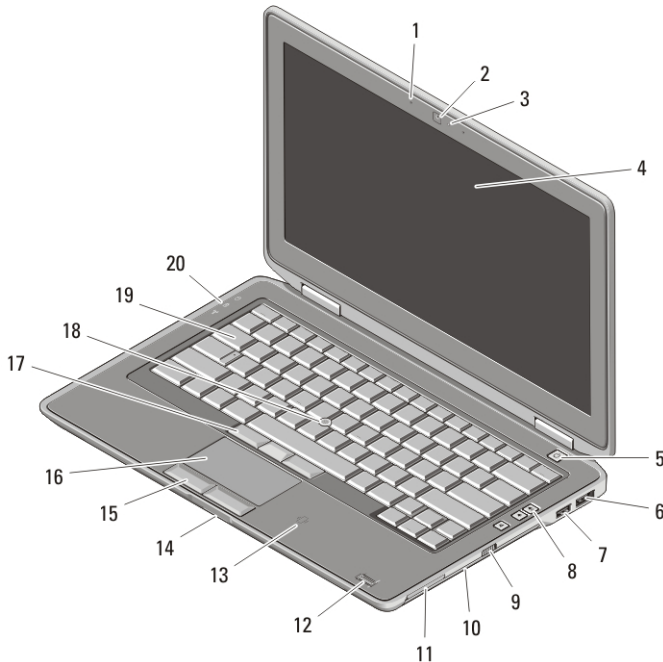


Figure 1. Front view

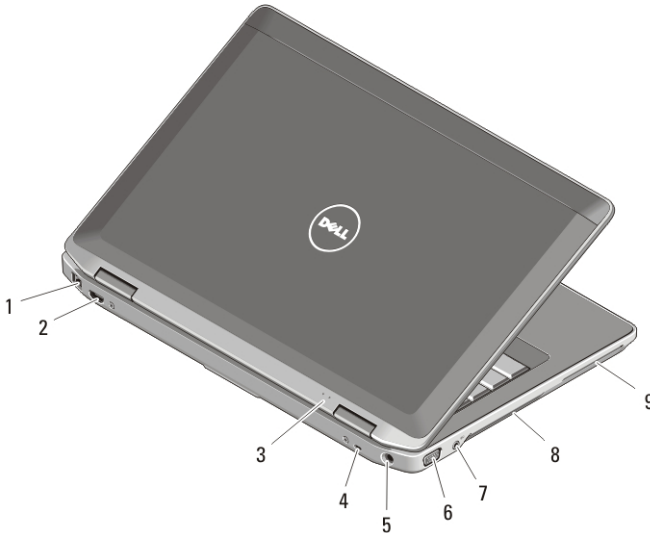



Figure 2. Back view

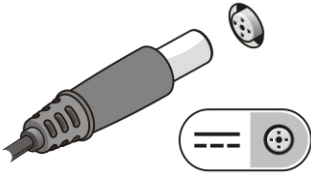


Figure 3. AC Adapter

2. Connect the network cable (optional).

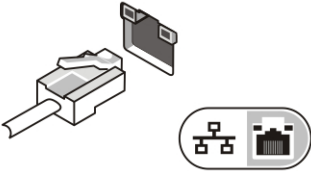


Figure 4. Network Connector

3. Connect USB devices, such as a mouse or keyboard (optional).

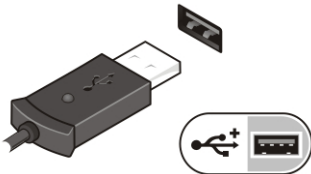



Figure 5. USB Connector
