


Figure 1. Front View




Figure 2. Back View




Figure 3. Front View




Figure 4. Back View




Figure 5. Front view




Figure 6. Back view




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Installing Handle Assembly (Latitude E6430 ATG)

1. Insert a paper clip into the release holes to unlock and remove the covering plugs from their slots.



2. Place the handle assembly into the slots. Use the screws to tighten and secure the handle assembly to the computer.

1. Connect the AC adapter to the AC adapter connector on the computer and to the electrical outlet.




Figure 7. AC Adapter

2. Connect the network cable (optional).




Figure 8. Network Connector

3. Connect USB devices, such as a mouse or keyboard (optional).




Figure 9. USB Connector

4. Open the computer display and press the power button to turn on the computer.




Figure 10. Power Button

5. Connect the external antennae (purchased by customer) to the RF cable (provided by Dell) present on the RF board. (Applicable only for E6430 ATG)




Figure 11. RF Pass Connector
