# Information We Collect

#### Information We Automatically Collect

We may also collect information about how your system or device has interacted with the Dell Solutions, such as statistical information and environment information. In some instances, the information collected may directly or indirectly identify an end-user and link an individual to certain online behavior to the extent required for the purposes provided in this Notice.

Information is collected by using Dell Platinum Direct API. The types of technology used by Dell may change over time as technology evolves. ### How We Use Personal Information

Dell may use your personal information to (i) analyze customer interests, behavior and preferences to help us better understand our customers, improve our products, services and solutions and enhance customer experience (ii) marketing research; (iii) verify compliance, monitor services and infrastructure performance to ensure integrity, stability and security of the Dell Solutions; or (vi) perform other functions or serve other purposes, as disclosed to you at the point of collection, or as required or permitted by law.

#### How We Share Personal Information

Dell will share your personal information within Dell Technologies and its group of companies for the purpose of improving and optimizing our product and services. We may also pass on your information to a third party for purpose of providing customer and technical support, provide services on our behalf such as data analysis and provide customers with information about the Dell Solutions

### **Data Transfers**

Your data may be transferred outside of your country to other locations such as USA. We will normally collect personal information from you only where we have your consent to do so, where we need the personal information to perform a contract with you, or where the processing is in our legitimate interests (and

not overridden by your data protection interests or fundamental rights and freedoms). We may also have a legal obligation to collect personal information from you.

# Your Data Protection Rights

You may have, among others, the following rights under applicable law to: (i) request access to the personal data that we hold about you; (ii) correct or request, deletion of personal data; and (iii) request Dell to stop processing your personal data (except to the extent required or permitted under applicable statute or other law).
