
Dell Graphics Card

Quick Setup Guide

1 Install the graphics card in your computer

Install the graphics card in a PCI-E x16 slot on your computer. For information on opening the computer cover, location of the slot, and installing the graphics card, see the *Service Manual* or *Owner's Manual* of your computer at **Dell.com/support/manuals**.




NOTE: The type and number of power cables that you need to connect to the card may vary depending on the card you purchased.

2 Download and install the drivers for your graphics card

- 1. Go to Dell.com/support.
- Click Product support.
- Click View products→ Electronics & Accessories→ Graphics Card and select your graphics card.
- 4. Click Drivers & downloads.
- 5. Select the operating system installed on your computer.
- 6. Scroll down the page and expand Video.
- 7. Under your graphics-card model, click **Download File** and save the file.
- **8.** After the download is complete, open the file and follow the instructions on the screen to install the drivers.

▶ NOTE: The graphics card may ship with an extender connected to it. Depending on your computer model, you may need to disconnect the extender from the card before you install the card. Retain the extender and screws to get warranty support.
