Installing your SIM card and activating your mobile broadband Service

1. Install the SIM Card

CAUTION: To avoid damage to the SIM card from electrostatic discharge, do not touch the SIM card connectors during installation or removal.

To install the SIM card:




Insert the SIM card into the slot

To connect to the network, go to **View** Available Networks and select cellular to turn on the cellular radio.


2. Connect to the Windows 10. network

Select **Advanced Options** and the options are displayed.



 d. Make a note of the International Mobile Equipment Identity (IMEI) and the Integrated Circuit Card Identifier (ICCID).



3. Install the Drivers

- a. Go to **Dell.com/support**.

- c. Click Get drivers and select View All Drivers to go to the Drivers and Downloads page.
- d. Select your operating system from the drop-down menu.
- e. Select the driver for your mobile broadband card from the Modem/Communications group.
- f. Download the driver.
- g. Run the installer, and follow the installation instructions.
